

- 39 million people dress up for Halloween in the UK and 90% of families buy new costumes every year.
- Most of these costumes (69%) are made up of polyester, a fabric made from oil-based plastic
- In the UK the average cost is £15.56 (totalling £510m) a year spent on Halloween costumes. Only 14% are home-made!
- 2 in 5 of those costumes are only worn once before being thrown into the bin.
- But 73% are happy to wear a used costume from a friend or relative.
